CCLS is seeing a steady increase in positive COVID cases with our employees. Please read and then post the following update in each program.

What you are doing **now**

- Surgical **Masks** (not cloth) must be worn by all employees during your work shift
- At the beginning of your work shift complete the COVID-19 Employee Screening Form and notify your manager if any positive symptoms are noted, prior to entering the building
- Continue to follow our [Infection Prevention and Control policy](#)
- Follow the separate guidelines when caring for a positive resident/client

What is **new**?

- In addition to your mask, it is now a CDC requirement to wear **goggles** during your work shift
 - Every county in Wisconsin is currently at a HIGH COMMUNITY TRANSMISSION level
 - Once the transmission rate falls to a "moderate" level the goggles will not be required.
 - Refer to the [CDC COVID Data Tracker](#) to determine what your community transmission level is and PPE should be worn while you are at work

When do we have to start wearing the goggles?

- Once the goggles are given to you (within the next 30-days) they will be required to be worn while at work
- Goggles are being ordered and sent to the Area Directors for current employees
- HR Recruiters will receive goggles for new employees
- Each employee will be given their own goggles
- Write your name on the adjustment strap
- If you work multiple facilities take the goggles with you
- Follow the cleaning instructions that you receive with your goggles

COVID Vaccines and the **Booster**:

- Get the COVID vaccine.
 - Ask your primary care physician for their guidance.

- COVID-19 Booster Vaccination:
 - The Pfizer Booster Vaccination has been approved for people based on the following guidelines:
 - You received the Pfizer two-dose primary series at least six months ago
 - You are 65 years and older
 - Or you are between 50–64 years with an underlying medical condition(s)
 - Or you are considered “high risk” category
 - Or if any of you are between 18 and 64 years of age whose frequent institutional settings (which most of you do) like:
 - AFH's
 - Assisted Living
 - CBRF's
